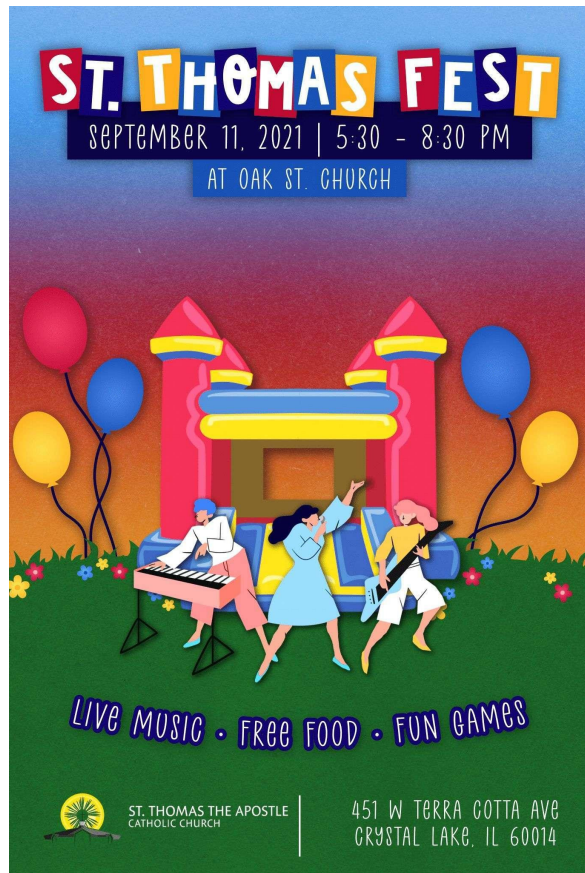
9/11 Now we're cooking!
